Wed, June 12	Depart for St. Andrews. Visit martyrdom sites of Patrick Hamilton and George Wishart. Explore abbey ruins. Take walking tour of St. Andrews, and play the putting course at the birthplace of golf. Arrive at Oban. Supper, free time, and overnight in Oban.
Thurs, June 13	Take ferry to Isle of Mull and Isle of Iona; tour birthplace of Scottish Christianity. Supper, free time, and overnight in Oban.
Fri, June 14	Journey to Ambleside in the beautiful Lake District. Supper, vespers, and overnight in the Lake District.

Sabbath, June 15	Breakfast and Sabbath morning worship. Depart for Oxford, C.S.
